



After Joshua died, all the people of Israel disobeyed God and left Him out of their lives.


After Joshua died, all the neighboring Midianites burn Israel's crops and houses. The Israelites had to live in caves.









In the dream, a loaf of bread tumbled against a Midianite tent and destroyed it.







Gideon planned a night attack. He gave each soldier a trumpet, and empty pitchers with torches inside.

They surrounded the Midianite army.


